RE: REMINDER Ongoing Billing for Claim Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Data Collection Services

The Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation's (DWC) designated data collection agent Verisk is authorized to collect fees from insurance carriers, other than governmental entities, to recover its necessary and reasonable costs for collecting Texas Claim EDI 3.1.4 data.

Earlier this year, Verisk completed billing carriers for one-half of the \$368,350 one-time startup cost. The DWC reminds carriers that Verisk will bill for the remaining half of the one-time costs plus the cost to process the first year of Texas Claim EDI 3.1.4 transactions on or after the live date of July 26, 2023.
